BMP3 – BMP4

- **BMP3** published in June 2010 by Industry.
- 50,000 copies of the booklet, in addition to softcopy pdf, have now been distributed by Industry.
- A number of aspects of **BMP3** are now out of date and require revision.
- Essential that BMPs are reviewed and updated to ensure piracy counter measures and reporting procedures are as effective as possible.
- Process is well underway to produce **BMP4**.



Draft BMP4 – Likely Changes

- Now includes an executive summary - the three fundamental requirements of BMP - at the beginning of the document.
- Amends the High Risk Area by excluding the Arabian Gulf.
- Company Planning and Ship Master's Planning now summarised in tables.
- The section on Citadels includes reference to an Industry paper on Citadels on the MSCHOA / NATO Shipping Centre websites and states Naval / Military forces criteria applied before boarding will be considered to release those in a Citadel.
- New section on Armed Private Maritime Security Contractors - includes a reference to IMO guidance included on the MSCHOA and NATO Shipping Centre websites.
- Guidance on the assistance provided by INTERPOL.
- New annex containing additional advice for leisure craft including yachts.

BMP4 - Distribution

BMP4 is of little value if it does not get to ships


- Industry will coordinate through a Distribution Plan.
- Softcopy pdf. version.
- 50, 000 copies of BMP4 booklet for distribution.
- Distribution through Industry associations.
- Distribution direct to ships through Bunker Suppliers / Port Agents .
- Distribution by Naval / Military forces.
- Updates on distribution will be provided to SHADE / WG3.

BMP4 – The Movie

- Steamship Mutual P&I commissioned the production of a 40 minute training film “**Piracy: the Menace at Sea**” for its members.
- A training film for seafarers to promote the BMP message.
- Film made with support of **EUNAVFOR, NATO Shipping Centre, UKMTO and Industry.**
- Film will be launched shortly to coincide with the publication of BMP4.
- Industry (**BIMCO, ICS, INTERCARGO, INTERTANKO, ITF, OCIMF & SIGTTO**) will purchase an additional 10,000 copies of the film for distribution on DVD to ships with BMP4.
- Industry have paid for subtitle translations on the DVD into Mandarin, Russian & Tagalong.
